### **Western Communities Football League (WCFL) Announces New Camp, July 17<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> at Village Park with NFL Legendary Players Jason Taylor and Sam Maddison**

WELLINGTON – The Western Communities Football League (WCFL), which has been the starting point for numerous major college and NFL players, is hosting a tackle football camp called the WCFL Tackle Football Showcase July 17<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> at the WCFL Football Fields in Pierson Park in Wellington. The Camp Director will be Coach Reggie Harris, Assistant Head Coach at St. Thomas Aquinas High School. Harris has over 20 years' experience coaching football and is a 7-time High School Football State Champion between California and Florida.

This camp has a big Wow factor.”

The schedule Harris has put together will provide Heads Up football technique, conduct NFL combine like testing of each participant, encourage competition, all with a lot of fun activities. “We have legendary South Miami Trainer Tony Sands who will be conducting NFL testing and ranking of the participants and we will have 9 on 9 competitions the last day of the camp. This along with some agility and speed training and specific position training make this camp one parents don't want their kids to miss.” Says Harris.

John Navarro, President of the WCFL BOD explains the league wanted to change things up this year. “Our board wanted to take our summer football camp to another level and make it really fun and exciting for the kids. We had hoped to add some great coaches, but we never thought we could get the group of coaches we have now for the camp.” Navarro goes on to say, “Attending a camp like this for youth is a great opportunity to get some really good coaching learning from some of the best coaches and former players in football.”

Each participant will be provided with proper fitting helmet and shoulder pads for the camp even though there will be only very little light contact in the camp. The participants should wear shorts and cleats and bring extra water. The camp is open to anyone wanting to attend ages 5-15 until the camp registration is full. Navarro adds. “This camp is so spectacular that we might have to close registrations if it gets too full as every youth football player in our area will want to attend this camp.”
